- POACRE FY21 Budget now in review

Pavilion Status

- Collected about \$13,500 in donations
- Action for POACRE to submit permit application to county

• P&P #9 Markup and submit to POACRE BOD for Approval

- Markupsee attached separate file. The changes noted are to a version of the P&P sent out to all prior to the committee meeting and made during the committee meeting. Because of the many changes to the P&P 9 currently in effect, it was not feasible to track changes in that document.
- Proposed fee same for all airport users based on 20 year cost analysis (see below)
- The draft updated P&P #9 will be forwarded to Admin after the board meeting this Saturday which will discuss the FY 21 budget.

20 Year Airport Costs

Runway: Repaving \$137,500
Runway: Resealing \$60,000
Lawn Equipment \$5,000
Total \$202,500

\$202,500/20 years = \$10,125/year*

If there are 23 users, this is \$440 per user per year

If the user fee is \$350 this works out to

\$10,125 - (23 * \$350) = \$2,075 shortfall per year

After 20 years this is a shortfall of \$41,500

*Currently POACRE provides the following: Insurance \$2000/year Gas and utilities \$1000/year
